Communique

1. The Special Bidding Committee, having examined and approved the non-financial proposal from all three bidders attending the present bidding, and considering clause 1.3 of the Bidding Notice no. 1/2019, declares Allianz Worldwide Care's financial proposal as the winning bid. The second lowest bid is that of Cigna International. United Healthcare Global's financial proposal was disqualified, pursuant to clause 6.4.4 of the above-mentioned notice.
2. The Committee also informs that bidders will be given the opportunity to state their intention to appeal by 12 noon on April 7th, if requested by the interested bidder. The letter of intention to appeal must be submitted to compraslicitacoes.efny@itamaraty.gov.br with supporting arguments, i.e., indicating against which decisions it intends to appeal and the reasons thereof. Once the intention to appeal is granted by the Committee, the bidder shall have three business day to submit its appeal.
